**POLICY ON SINGLE COURSES
FOR CREDIT:**

Single courses can be taken for credit if the student is eligible and with the permission of the instructor.

To assess eligibility, the student must:

1. Fill out this application.
2. Provide application fee of \$25.00 (check or money order made payable to: University of Philosophical Research)
3. Have their last educational institute mail their official transcript to UPR.

Single Course for Credit students will be provided with the access to the selected course's online classroom, which includes video and audio lectures, course guides and a weekly study plan. They will be graded for midterm and final assignments and will be able to complete weekly quizzes for self learning and participate in the forum discussion and teleconferences. If eligible, single courses for credit can be taken for \$498 per course for BA courses and \$540 for MA courses.
